As diabetes care increasingly relies on continuous glucose monitoring (CGM), insulin pumps, automated insulin delivery (AID) systems, and connected data platforms, many healthcare organizations face challenges related to fragmented adoption, workflow complexity, limited data integration, and financial sustainability. The DTMM was developed to address these challenges by providing a structured framework to help organizations assess their current capabilities and plan for scalable diabetes technology integration.

This interactive, one-hour workshop will:

- Introduce the draft **Diabetes Technology Maturity Model (DTMM)**
- Review its **six core domains** and **six progressive maturity levels**
- Guide participants through a **live self-assessment**, providing a snapshot of their organization's current state
- Gather feedback on both the **model framework** and the **self-assessment experience**

Participant insights will directly inform refinement of the DTMM as it progresses toward a validated national framework to support technology-enabled diabetes care.
